Timeline for the project:

Mid to late February:

- Go over the first draft to refine things: Any section that is too content-rich gets refined so that the general advice is moved to a dedicated book (EX: if the "managing the kitchen" session is too long we make a book about cooking and keep it short in the good gathering guide).
